TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR HOME CREATING BRUSH CLEARANCE

Do you live in an <u>at-risk area</u> for wildfires?
Follow these tips for clearing an area around your home to reduce the risk of damage to your home and livelihood:

- Remove all dead foliage and undergrowth regularly
- Keep weeds and grass ≤ 3 inches tall
- Maintain 5ft clearance between the roof and any tree branches
- Trim trees 10ft away from the rest of the home and other foliage
- Limit combustible items (deck chairs, planters) near home
- Create defensible space zones around the house
- Follow the rest of LAFD's <u>clearance requirements</u> for a safe home!
