<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maintain situational awareness on race activities and any impacts to the City.</li> <li>• Monitor media and coordinate public information related to the race.</li> <li>• Provide mass care coordination in support of field evacuations if an incident occurs in the City portion of the race.</li> <li>• Facilitate policy direction if needed.</li> <li>• Coordinate and share information with the UCP, the MACC, activated City DOCs, and any other applicable jurisdictional EOCs.</li> <li>• Provide resource support to the City UCP if requested.</li> <li>• Keep executives informed of significant race related incidents and EOC status.</li> <li>• Prepare a Mass Care Plan by 0900 to activate: 1) Family Reunification Center 2) Shelter to accommodate 1000 people inclusive of peoples with disabilities, access, and functional needs</li> </ul>
